Charter Statement

- Points to Include
 - O Goal: elimination of preventable, sleep-related deaths "chasing zero" no preventable sleep-related death is acceptable
 - o Multi-disciplinary, county-wide, multi-system initiative
 - ➤ Representation from multiple area healthcare facilities
 - Community partnerships
 - o Increase safe sleep awareness among clinicians and families
 - o Standardization of education
 - o Timeline 5 years

 - The Montgomery County Safe Sleep Coalition aims to eliminate preventable, sleep-related deaths over a 5-year period by increasing safe sleep awareness among clinicians and families in our community through standardization of education, community partnerships, and county-wide community outreach initiatives.

- ❖ CFRT Data Collection Tool to be filled out on all sleep-related death in Montgomery County starting 2019
 - o Items to Include
 - Date of birth
 - Location of birth
 - Location of death zip code (to be reported out by county quadrants)
 - Gestational age (if available)
 - Birthweight
 - Prenatal Care
 - Maternal Risk Factors
 - Drugs/Alcohol
 - Obesity
 - Smoking
 - ➤ Maternal Parity
 - Breastfed vs. Bottlefed
 - Location of death in home crib vs other surface (swing, pack n play, parents bed, recliner, sofa, floor, carseat, etc).

- What was the infant wearing
- Last seen alive (number of hours)
- Anything on sleep surface with the infant
- Other circumstances around death
